THIS ARTICULATION AGREEMENT is specifically designed for students who have completed their AAS degree in majors other than business and are interested in completing their BA degree at Kendall's School of Business. They can earn their bachelor's degree in as little as two years or take the time required to fit school into their work schedule.

Our students can easily transfer previous course credits while receiving the benefits of a small college in a big city – exciting environment, small classes and individual attention.

AVAILABLE IN BOTH ON-GROUND AND ON-LINE OPTIONS. A typical sequence of study is provided on the back of this sheet.

Full-time day program: Full-time students who transfer from community college can earn a Bachelor of Arts in Business in as quickly as two years. They gain carefully sequenced classroom study and internship experience culminating in a unique integrative capstone project.

Combined online and weekend program for working adults: Through a combination of online work and five Saturday meetings per quarter, working adult students can earn the degree they want with the flexibility they need in as little as two years.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE – Kendall works with students to make higher education affordable. We have a generous scholarship program that recognizes outstanding academic achievement. In addition, our financial aid office helps our students secure the assistance they need to obtain the college education they want.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS – All students must complete minimum residency requirements of 48 quarter hours. In addition, the final 12 credits of coursework must be completed at Kendall.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS – Students must submit applications for admission and official transcripts from all colleges attended to the Kendall College Office of Admissions. Students with fewer than 15 semester hours of transferable college credit must submit an official high school or GED transcript. A minimum GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale (C average) is required for admission.

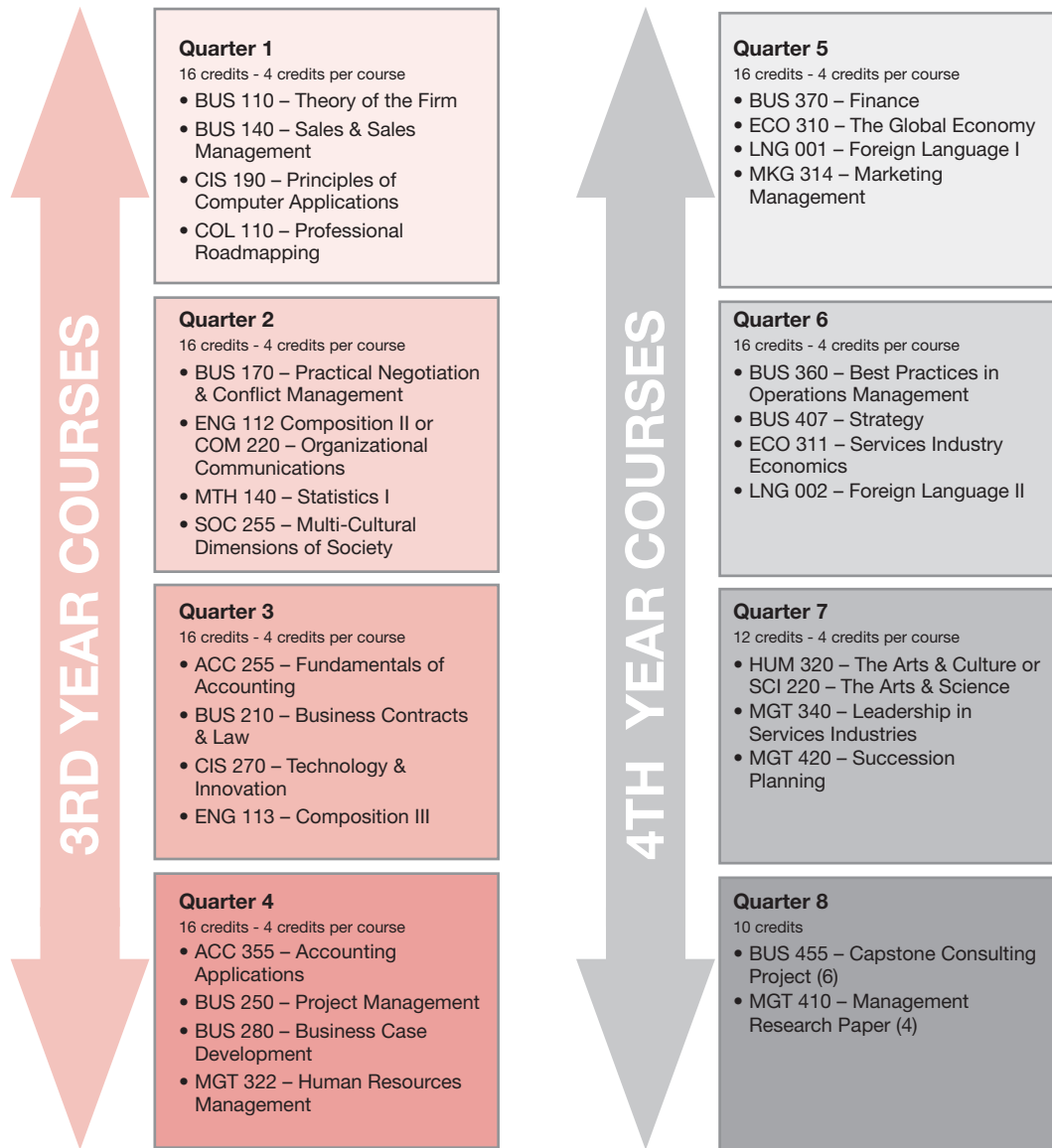

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TYPICAL 2-YEAR PROGRAM SEQUENCE

This sequence is designed for students who wish to complete their Bachelor's Degree as quickly as possible. Kendall advisors will work with students who wish to take a lighter class load to sequence their courses over a longer period of time.



For the combination online and onsite program there is an on-campus commitment of one Saturday per month.

Kendall works to meet individual needs.

- Up to 24 additional credits may be waived for courses taken in majors that represent courses from this sequence.
- In addition, considerations are made if students have had courses equivalent to those listed below.
- Credits are quarter hours.
- This chart does not include any additional English composition or math required to meet College requirements.
- Total credits toward BA must total a minimum of 120 semester hours or 180 quarter hours.
