



PRESIDENTIAL AND DEAN'S SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2016

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Any first-time enrolled student who meets the academic entry requirements below may apply for an award.
- Full-time enrollment in a degree program in either Culinary Arts, Baking and Pastry, Hospitality Management, Business or Early Childhood Education.
- The application deadline for the Presidential and Dean's scholarships is one month before the start of the intended term.

PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

VALUED AT 50% OF THE COST OF TUITION

Three letters of recommendation from either a professional or academic source and relate to the student's abilities to succeed in the chosen field

Applicants must submit/fulfill:

- GPA of 3.85 or above in most recent academic level (high school or college cumulative GPA)
- 26 ACT (or SAT equivalent) if high school is the most recent academic level
- Essay demonstrating commitment to the field of study
- Resume
- Interview with the President

DEAN'S SCHOLARSHIP

VALUED AT 25% OF THE COST OF TUITION

Two letters of recommendation from either a professional or academic source and relate to the student's abilities to succeed in the chosen field

Applicants must submit/fulfill:

- GPA of 3.6 or above in most recent academic level (high school or college cumulative GPA)
- 24 ACT (or SAT equivalent) if high school is the most recent academic level
- Essay demonstrating commitment to the field of study
- Resume
- Interview with the Dean

AWARD PROCEDURES

- Scholarships are valid only for enrollment beginning in the intended start term listed on the Scholarship Application. Students who delay their start must reapply.
- Scholarship decisions can be made only if all transcripts (at least unofficial) and required components are on file. Official transcripts must be on file by the end of the first quarter for awards to continue.
- For students who receive awards based on unofficial transcripts or those with coursework in progress, scholarship awards may be discontinued if final official transcripts indicate a GPA that does not meet the application requirements.
- The Presidential scholarship will be awarded as a 50% tuition reduction. The Dean's scholarship will be awarded as a 25% tuition reduction.
- Awards may not be combined with need-based institutional awards, or any other tuition reductions.

CONTINUATION OF SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS

- Students must maintain continuous full-time enrollment in a degree program and maintain good academic standing (2.0 Cumulative GPA).
- Eligibility for offer ends if a student graduates from this program, drops out or becomes inactive.
