



KENDALL APPLICATION STEPS

1. Online Application for Admission

Go to kendall.edu/apply

2. Personal Statement

An essay about you, your background and your future goals.

3. Evidence of English Proficiency

Kendall requires one of the following exams as proof of English proficiency:

- > **60 or higher on TOEFL iBT**
All subscores must meet minimum level of 15.
- > **5.5 or higher on IELTS**
Speaking and listening: 5.5 or higher
Reading and writing: 5.0 or higher
- > **46 or higher on Pearson Test of English(PTE)**

Proof of English Proficiency may be exempt in the following instances:

- > Educated in a high school for at least three years where English is the language of instruction.
- > Educated at a college or university for at least two years where English is the language of instruction.

4. Official Documents

All Transcripts must be translated into English.

- > Official Secondary/High School Transcripts with anticipated graduation date
- > Any previous College or University Official Transcripts
- > Official Transcripts must be delivered in one of two ways:
 1. Mailed in a sealed envelope directly from the institution to Kendall's Office of Admissions.
 2. Emailed directly from the institution to kendalladmissions@kendall.edu

5. An enrollment deposit is required at the time of acceptance of enrollment by all international students. The enrollment deposit is required to be paid before international students receive their visa documents.

- > International Students Seeking Housing
Deposit: \$1,300¹
\$1,000 is applied to fees. \$300 is a non-refundable housing fee.
- > International Students Not Seeking Housing
Deposit: \$1,000¹
\$1,000 is applied to fees.

J-1 VISA APPLICATION STEPS

Documents required to receive your DS-2019 to apply for your J-1 Exchange Visitor Visa

1. **Copy of your passport identity page**
Valid six months after entry in to U.S.
2. **Provide proof that you or your sponsor has access to the minimum funds for your studies.**
All Programs: \$16,000 or higher.
 - > Fees per year \$2,000
 - > Housing per year \$13,800
 - > Miscellaneous Fees: \$200
- > **Completed Confidential Statement of Support.**
If you are receiving funds from a sponsor, this form should be completed by both you and your sponsor indicating that you have access to the minimum funds for your studies and other expenses.

Acceptable forms of documentation:

1. Bank Balance Statement
- OR

2. Letter from Bank

These documents should be signed and stamped by a Bank Official.
